At Christmas time, we celebrate the birth of our Lord and Savior with


gift giving. We often get carried away with that part. But I am thankful for one special gift I have been given--the gift of you.

- · 3 tablespoons water
- · 3 tablespoons milk, whole preferred
- · 2 tablespoons AP Flour

Dough

We all loved Bailey White's homemade rolls!

- · 21/2 cups AP Flour
- · 1/4 cup granulated sugar
- · 1 teaspoon table salt
- · 1 tablespoon instant yeast
- · 2/3 cup whole milk
- · 1 large egg + 1 egg for egg wash
- · 4 tablespoons unsalted butter, melted
- · chopped rosemary, sage, and thyme
- olive oil for drizzling

For the dough: In the bowl of a stand mixer with a dough hook attachment, combine the tangzhong with the remaining dough ingredients. Mix on medium speed until a smooth dough forms. Shape the dough into a ball, transfer to a large mixing bowl, drizzle with olive oil, cover tightly with plastic and let rest for 1 hour.

Turn the dough out onto a lightly floured surface and stretch into a square. Gently roll out the dough then use a dough cutter to portion into 12 equal pieces. On an un-floured surface, roll each piece into a tight sphere.

Transfer to a greased quarter sheet tray. Cover with plastic and let rise for another 45 minutes.

Preheat the oven to 350. Brush the tops of the rolls with egg wash and transfer into the oven and bake for 25 minutes. Let cool in the pan for 10 minutes, then transfer to a wiring cooling
