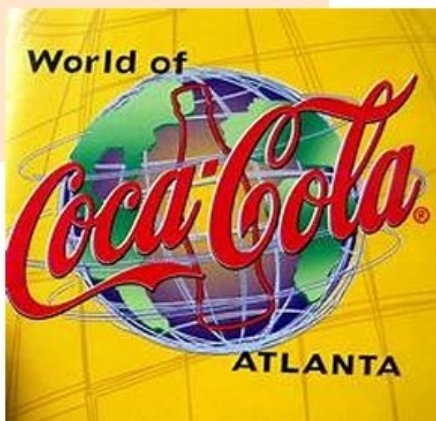


Baskets are in Narthex and in the hall near the office to accept donations for Help Center and Safeplace

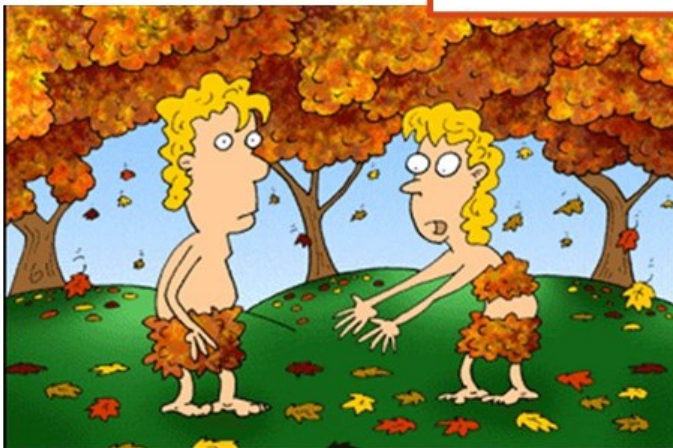

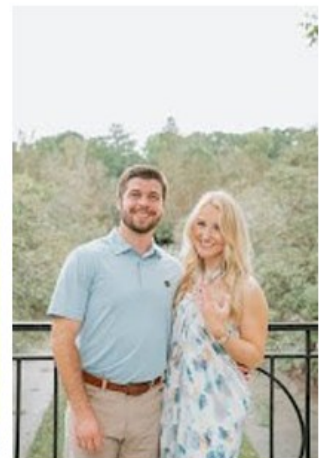

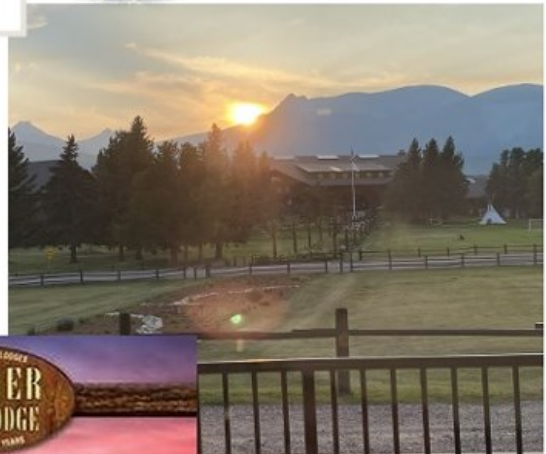
